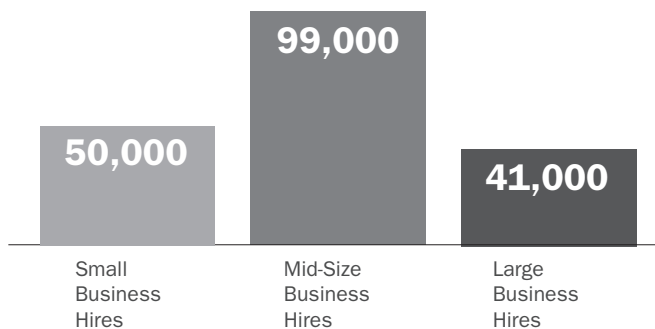

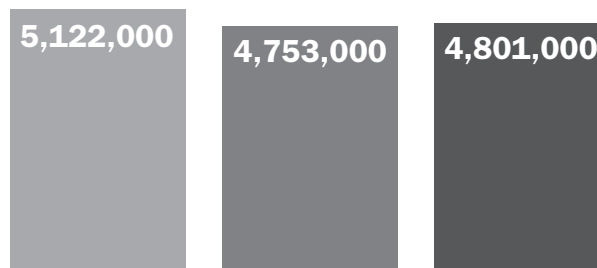

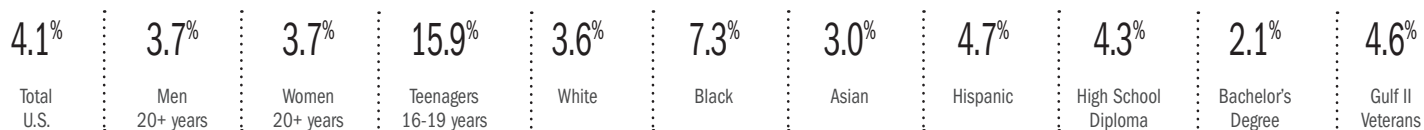

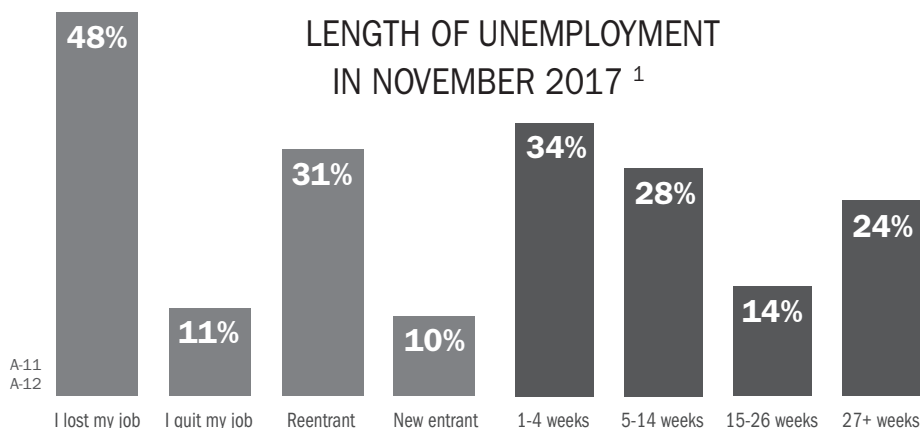

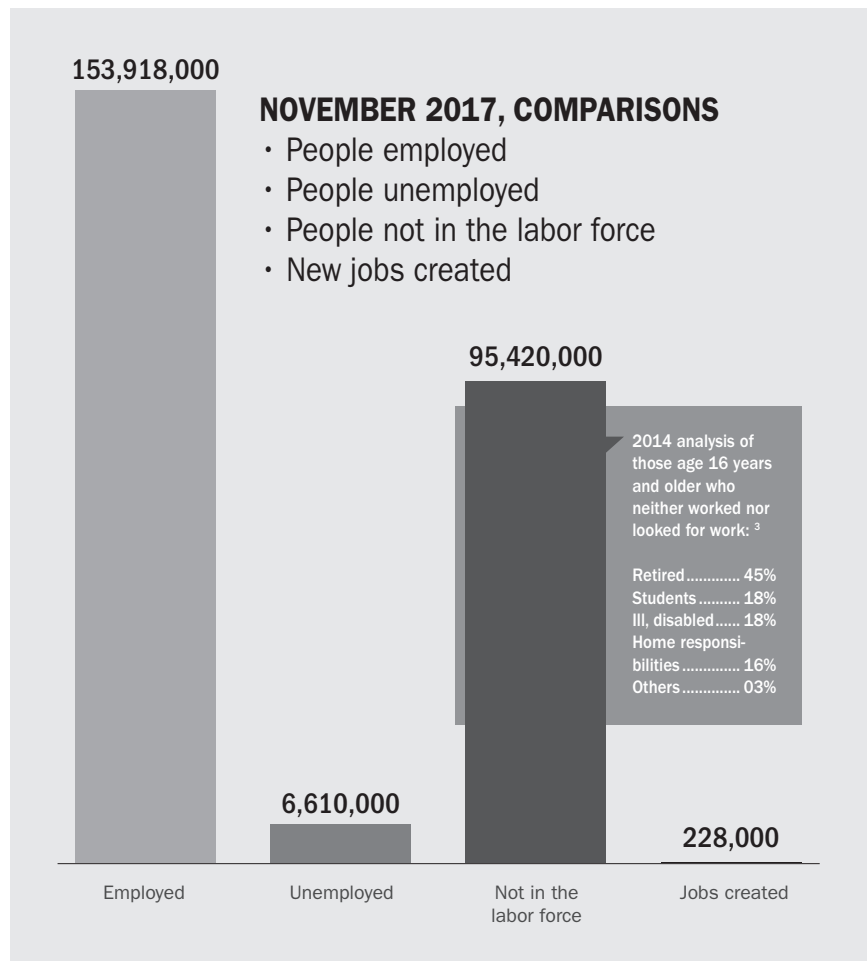
REASON FOR JOB LOSS & LENGTH OF UNEMPLOYMENT IN NOVEMBER 2017 ¹
