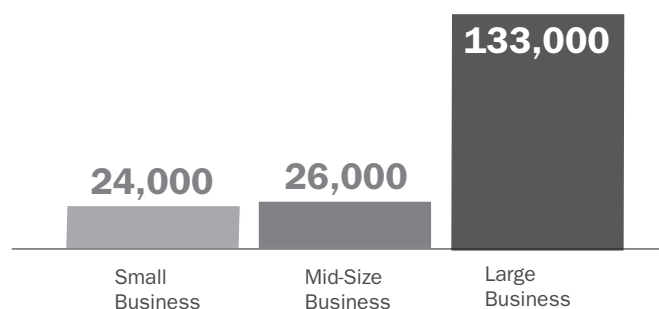

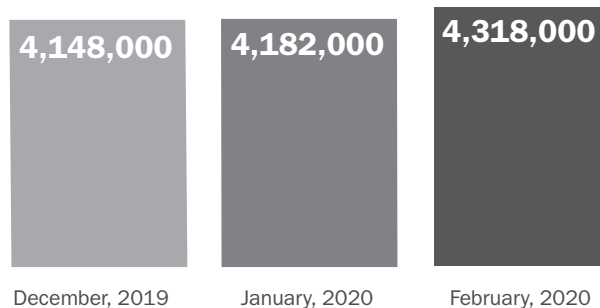

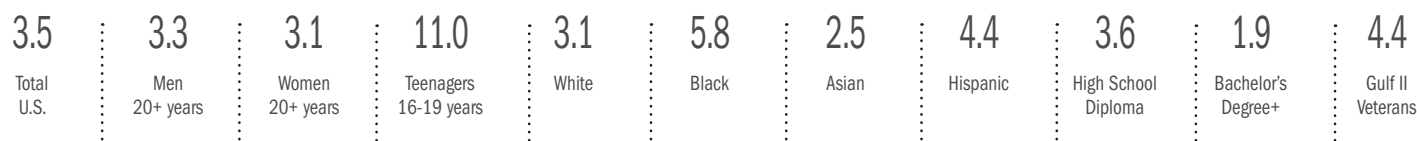

UNEMPLOYMENT RATES IN FEBRUARY, 2020¹

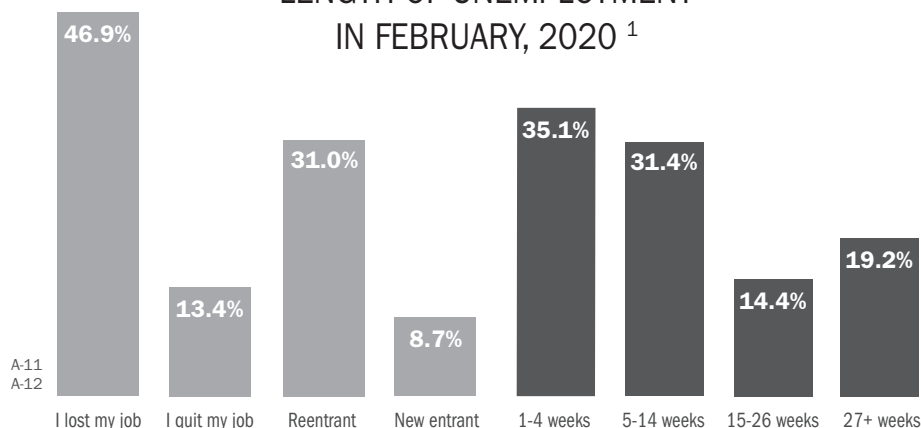

REASON FOR UNEMPLOYMENT & LENGTH OF UNEMPLOYMENT IN FEBRUARY, 2020¹

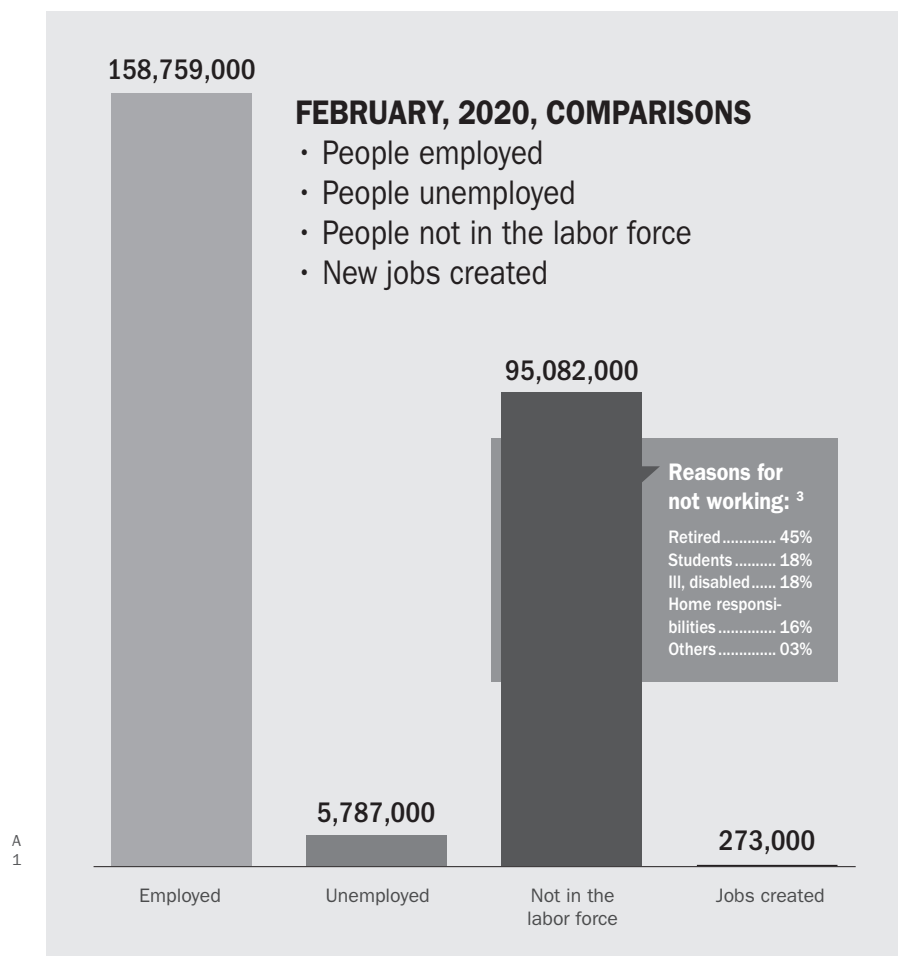
