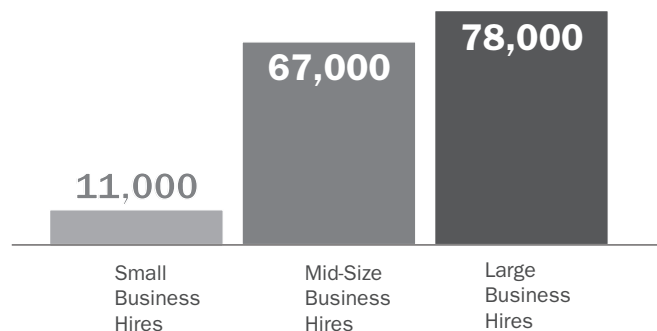

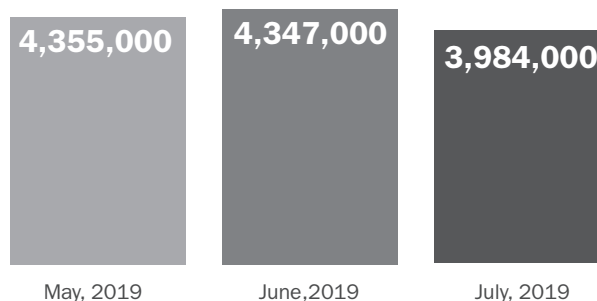

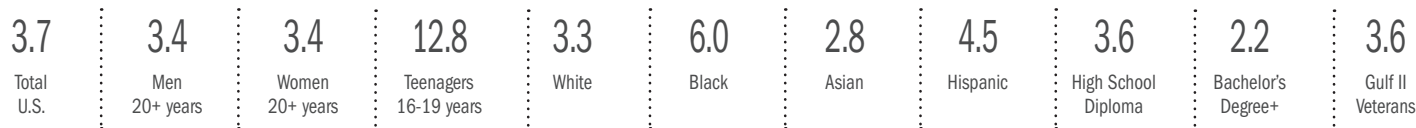

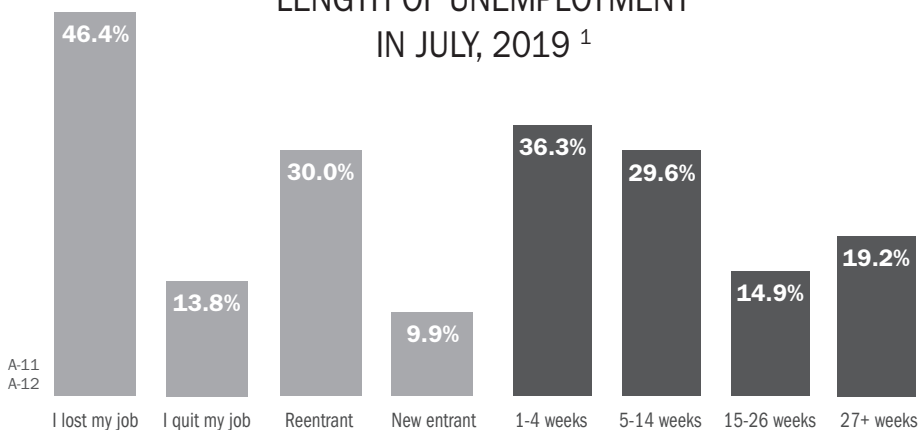

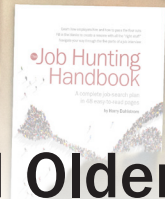

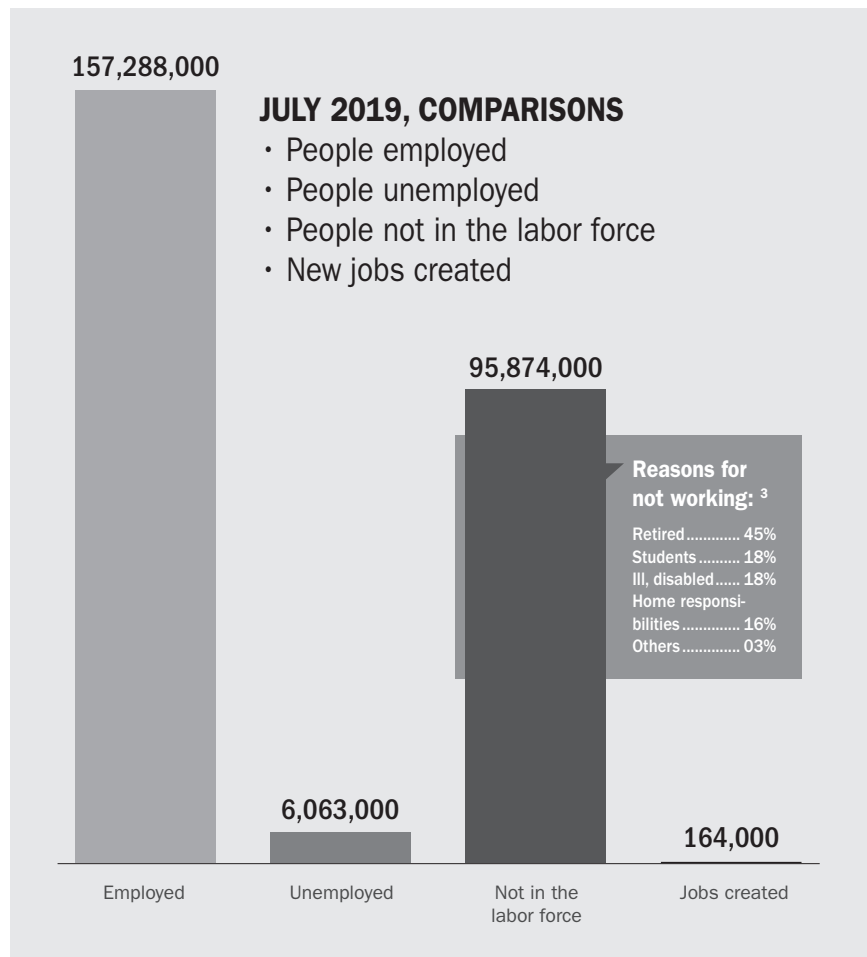
REASON FOR JOB LOSS & LENGTH OF UNEMPLOYMENT IN JULY, 2019¹
