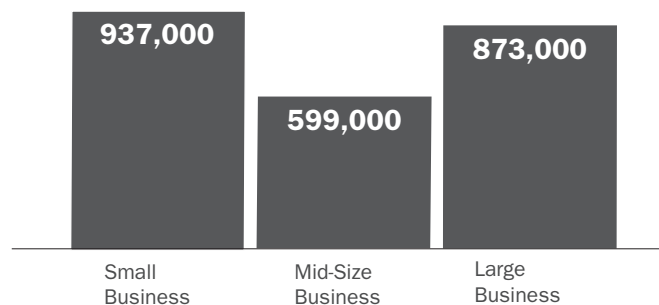

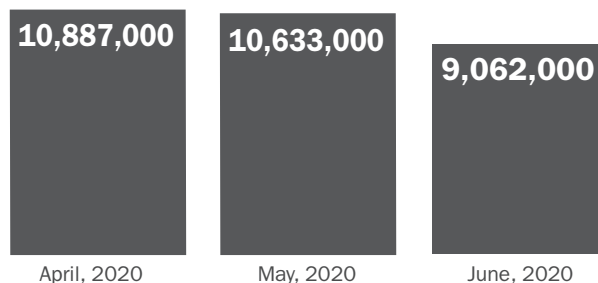

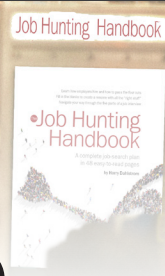
PEOPLE WORKING PART TIME FOR ECONOMIC REASONS¹

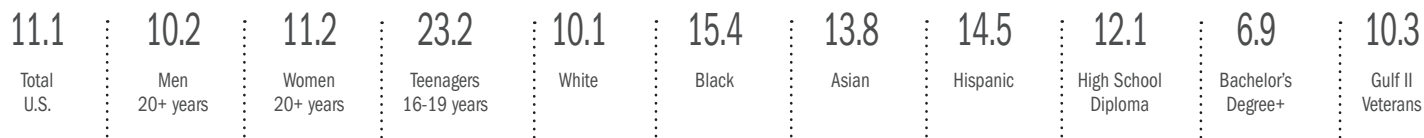

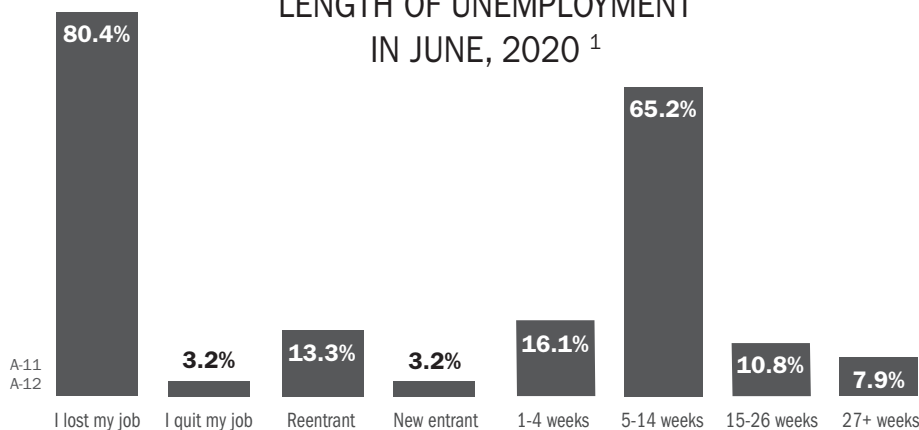
UNEMPLOYMENT RATES IN JUNE, 2020¹

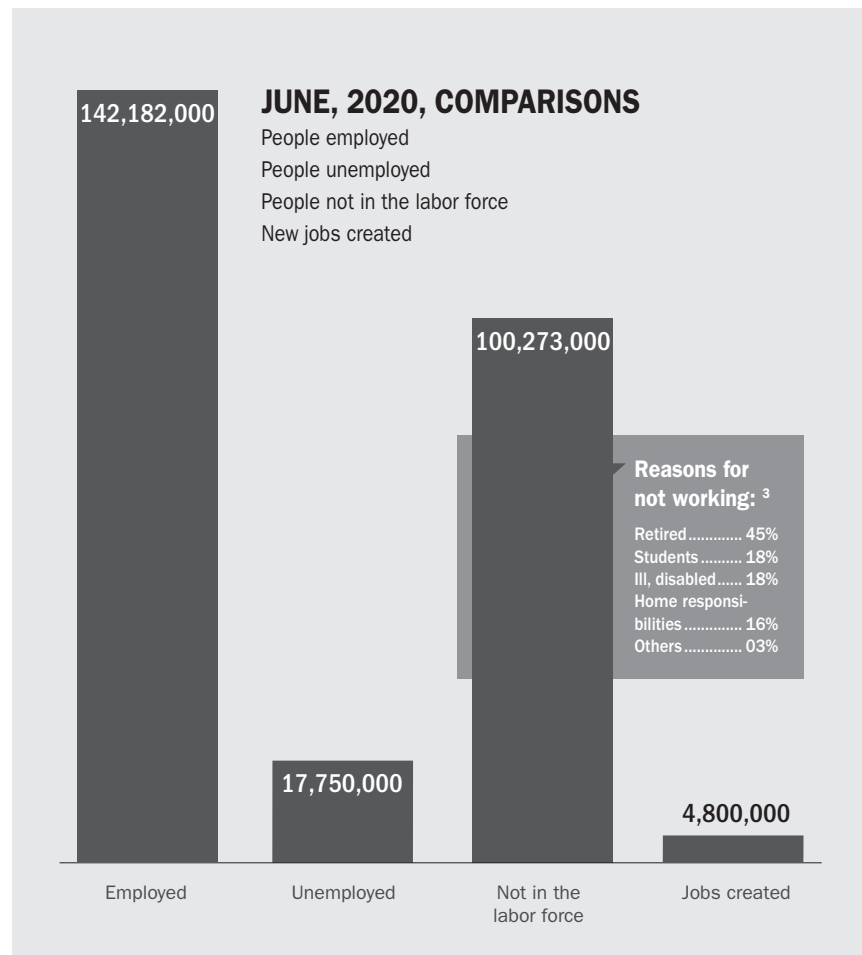
