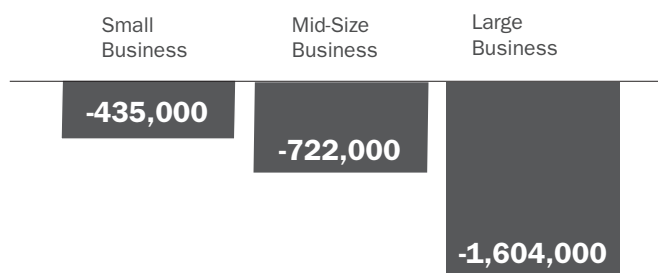

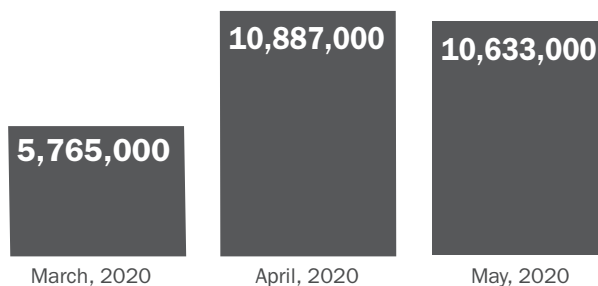

PEOPLE WORKING PART TIME FOR ECONOMIC REASONS¹



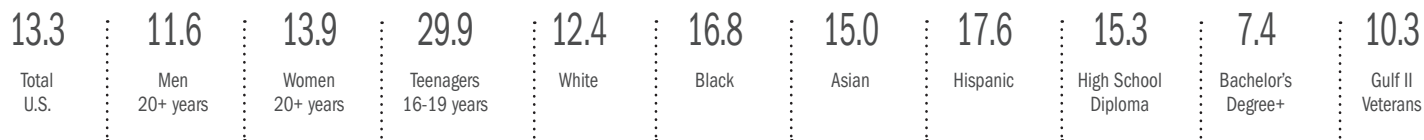

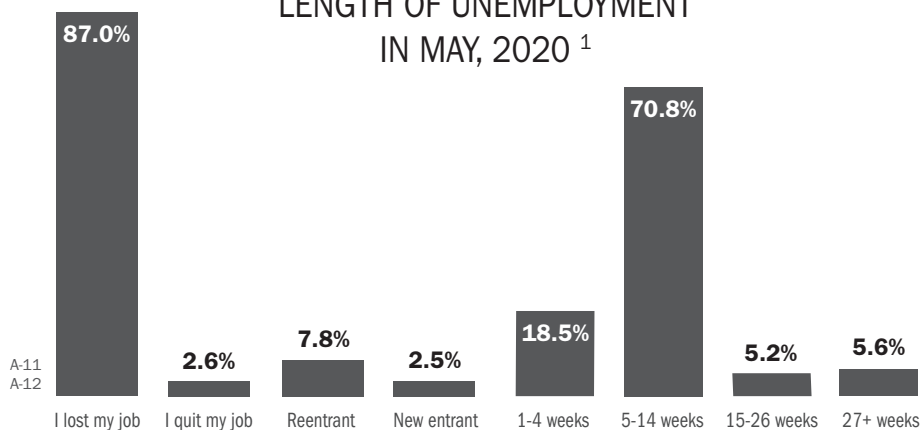
UNEMPLOYMENT RATES IN MAY, 2020¹

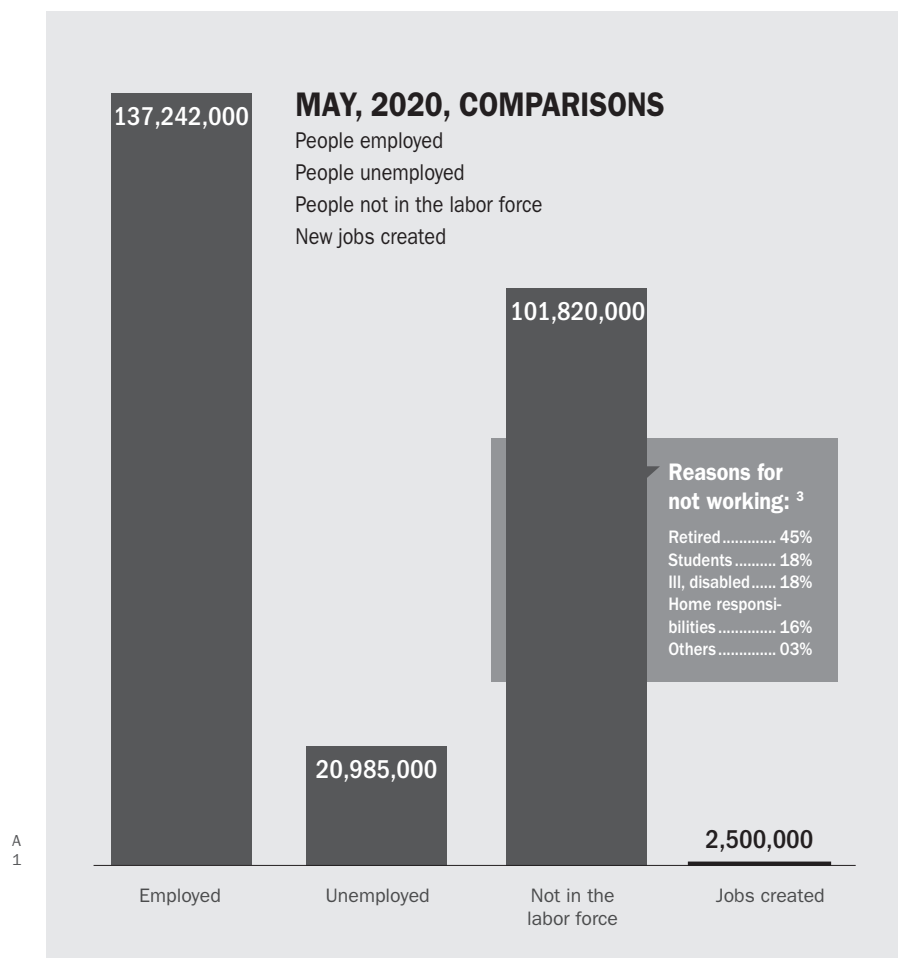
