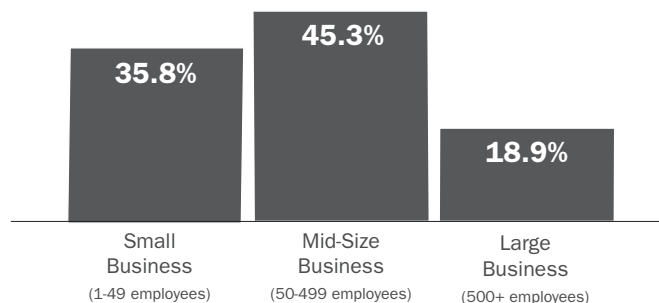

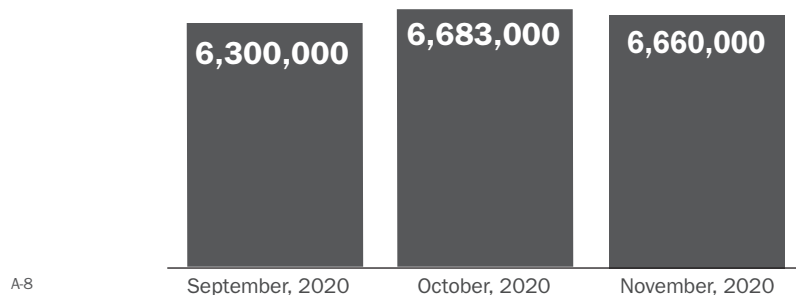

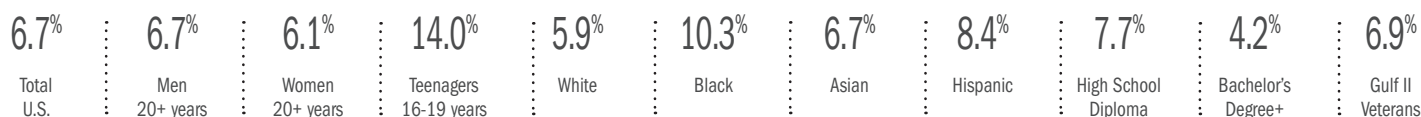

UNEMPLOYMENT RATES IN NOVEMBER, 2020 ¹

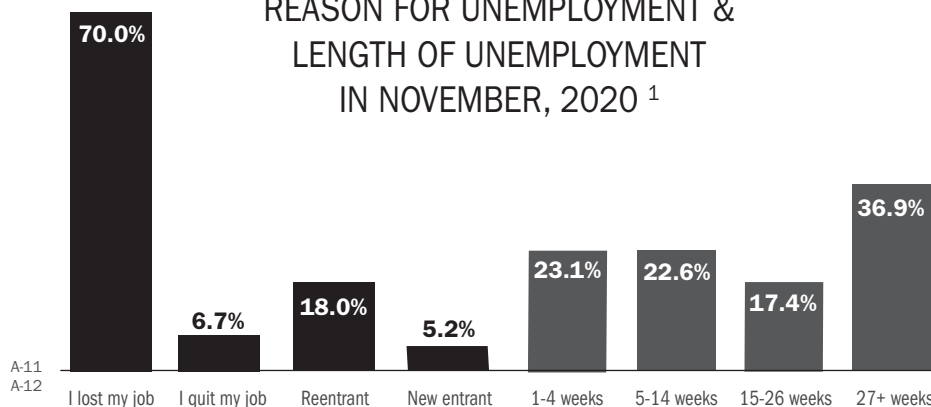

REASON FOR UNEMPLOYMENT & LENGTH OF UNEMPLOYMENT IN NOVEMBER, 2020 ¹

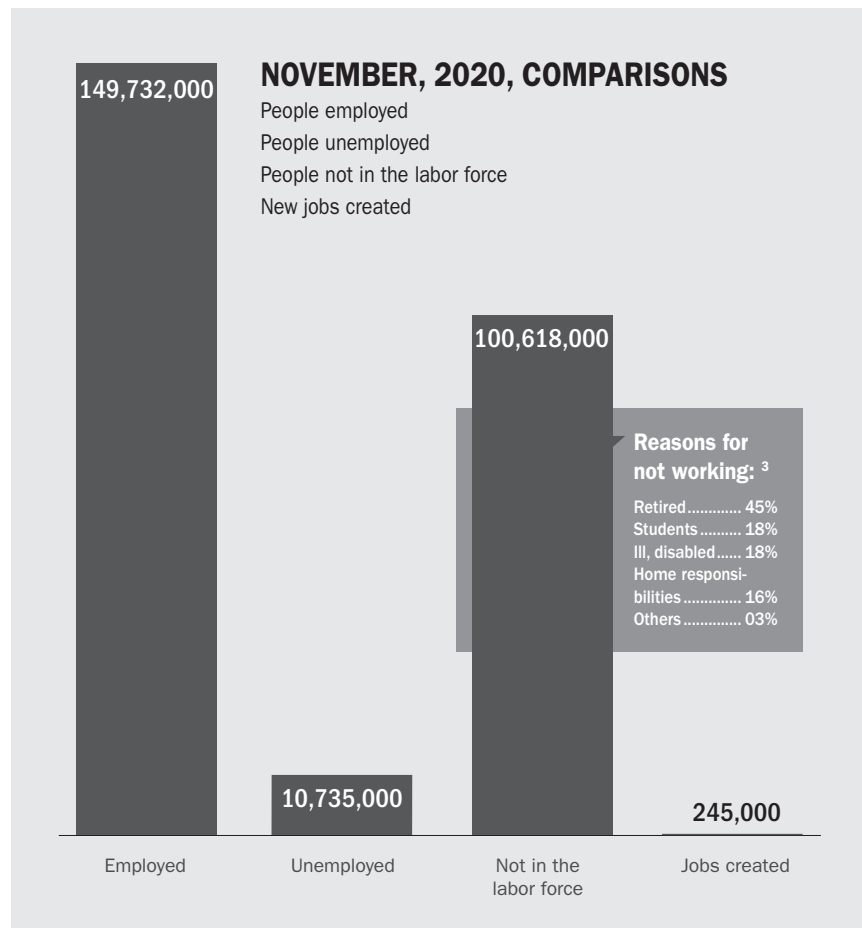
