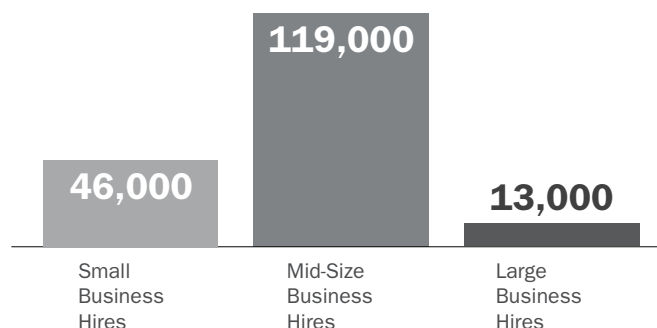

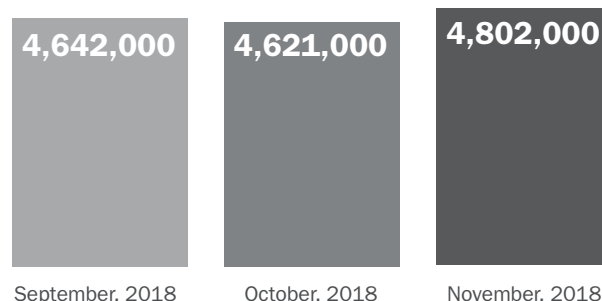

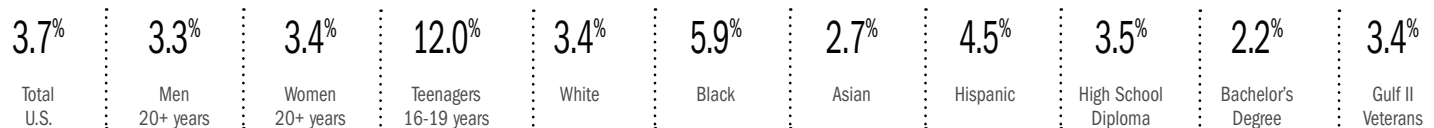

NOVEMBER 2018, UNEMPLOYMENT RATES ¹



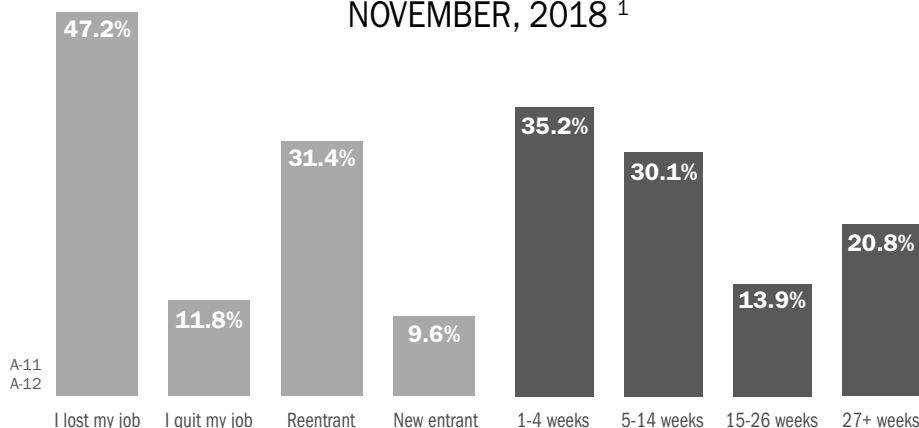

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REASON FOR JOB LOSS & LENGTH OF UNEMPLOYMENT NOVEMBER, 2018 ¹

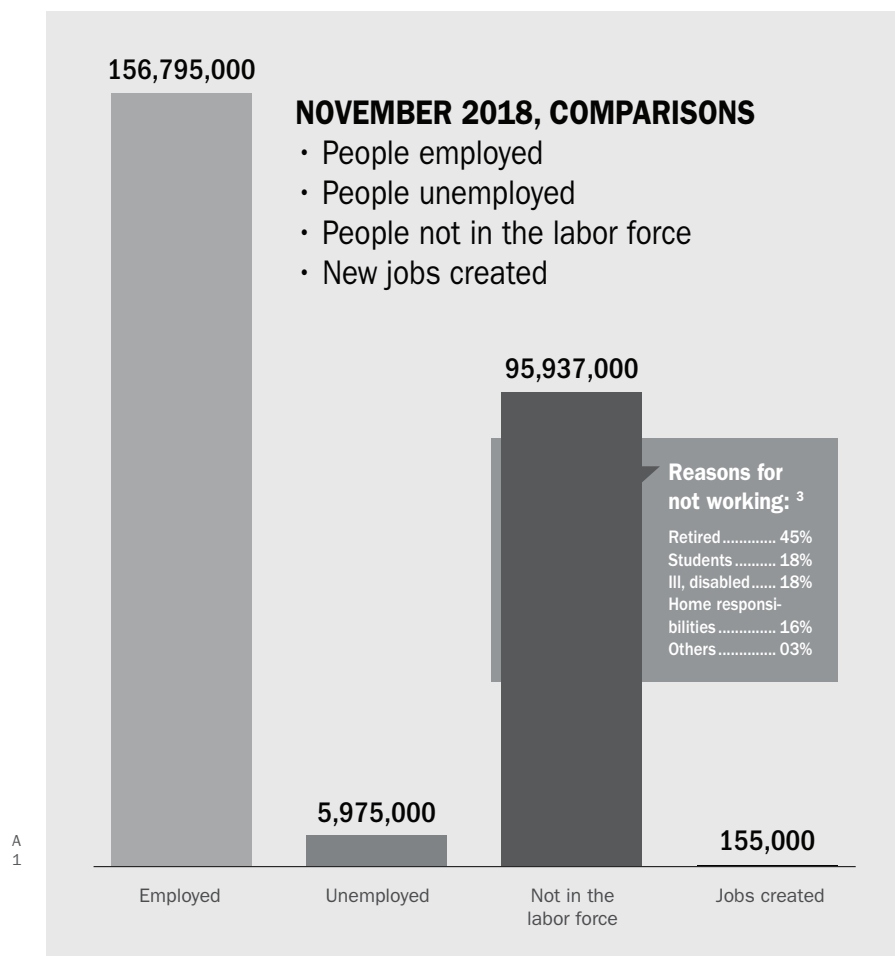
