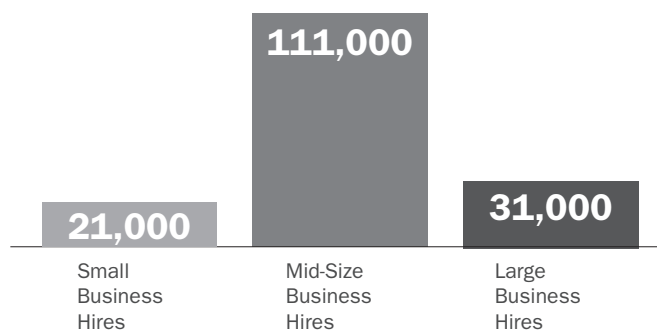

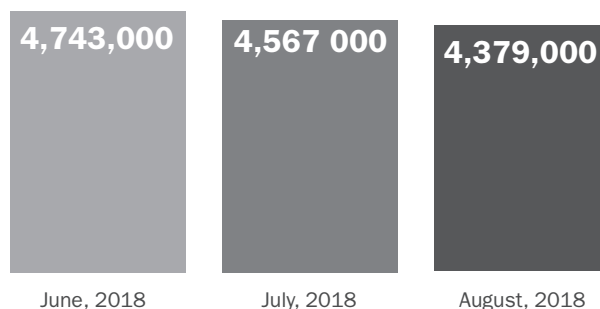

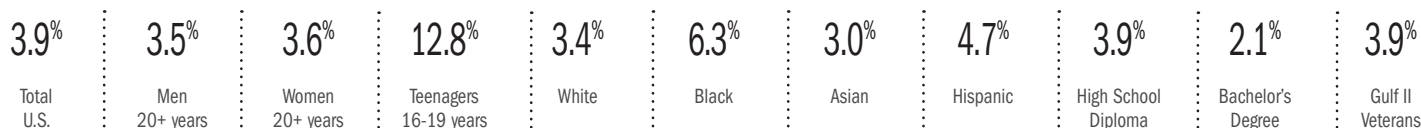

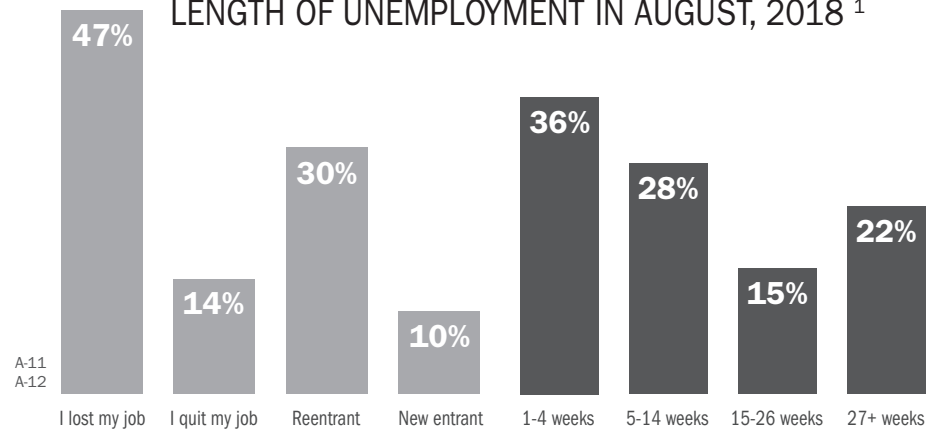

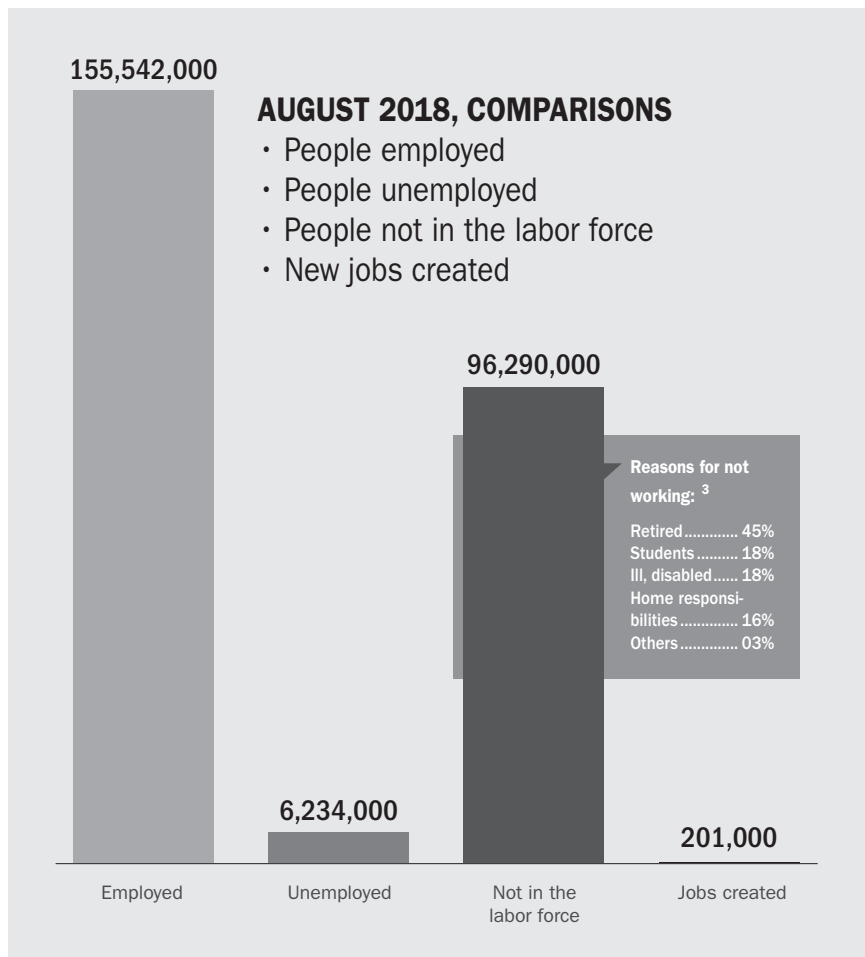
REASON FOR JOB LOSS & LENGTH OF UNEMPLOYMENT IN AUGUST, 2018 ¹
