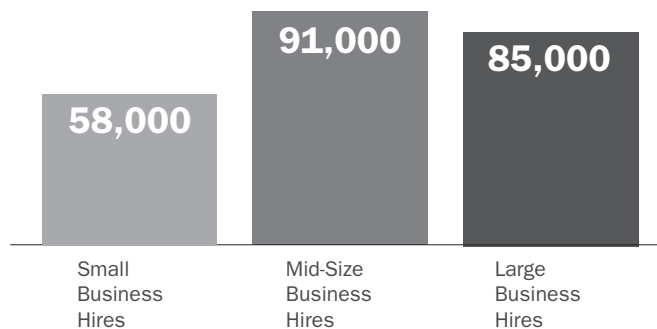

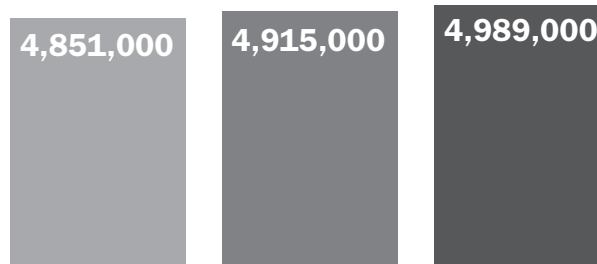

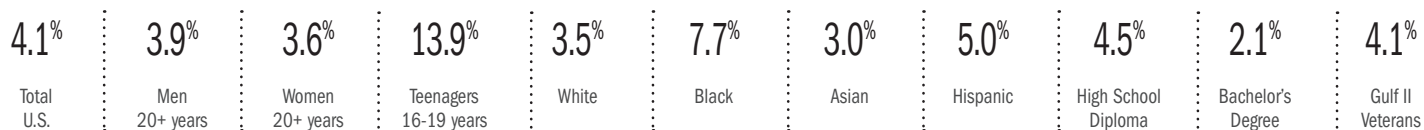

JANUARY 2018, UNEMPLOYMENT RATES ¹

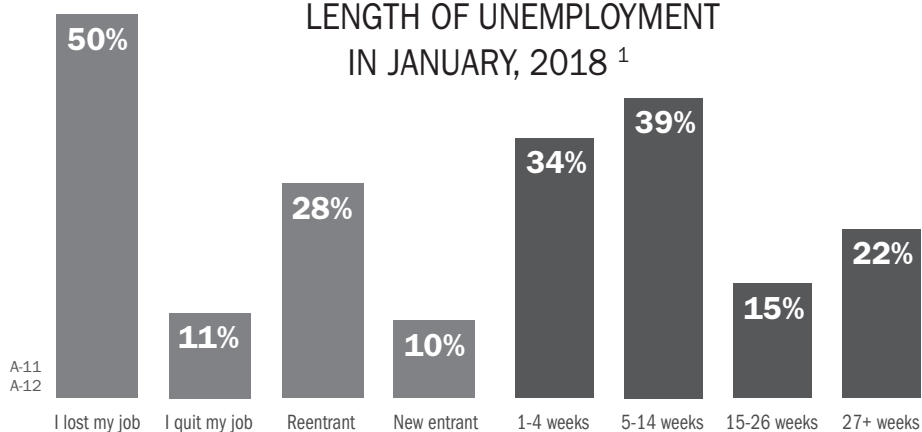

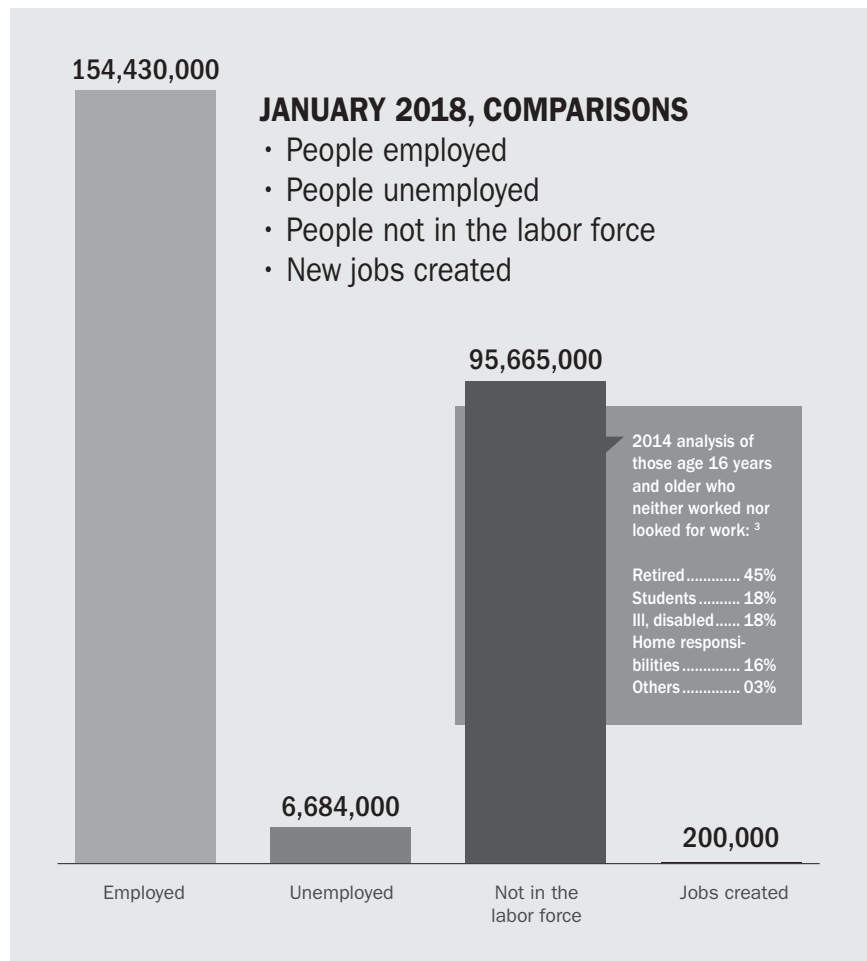
REASON FOR JOB LOSS & LENGTH OF UNEMPLOYMENT IN JANUARY, 2018 ¹
